FORT MERVINE'S, 4TH ANNUAL CIVIL WAR ENCAMPMENT. ANOTHER HUGE SUCCESS. – OCTOBER 8, 9 AND 10TH.

Monterey Bay weather was semi-clear at this years event on the grounds in front of the Presidio Museum, Friday morning began with a malfunctioning control burn in Fort Ord which resulted in showering the city of Monterey with Ash , including Fort Mervine, which cleared by 10:30 am, the Lincoln 10 tent took some time to clean. But the three day event went very well, members of Phil Sheridan 4 and Aux Mary Walker 52 participated for the 4th straight year. The Encampment also had an ACWA member from the 20th Maine, Garrett Hasslinger who participated playing 19th century tunes on his fife and participated on the firing detail on all three days , which gave two firing demo's daily. On Friday the firing detail was headed by Camp 4's Frank Avila, PCC, DJVC: Tim Reese (Camp 10) and Garrett Hasslinger (ACWA) of Prunedale. On Sunday the Dept. Color Guard Coord: Paul Lavrischeff arrived on Sunday morning, with an Ordnance display and commanded the firing detail all Sunday. There was Two Display Tents operated by Camp 10 and Camp 4. And 4 dog tents and two A frames to give it a good compound look. Also , reporters of the Monterey County Herald and the Salinas California Newspaper were there to cover the event. The Monterey County Herald placed the Civil War Encampment on the Front page of Mondays October 11th issue of the "Monterey County Herald", and additional photo on the last page of that section. The Salinas Californian put in a photo and a small caption on the second page. Saturday apparently was the busiest day of the three day event. *Coverage on Pages 3 & 4.*

***THE MESS TENT: " FRIED PARTRIDGES",-2-LOVELY, PLUMP PARTRIDGES. EGG YOLKS (BEATEN & SEASONED TO TASTE), BUTTER OR OIL FOR FRYING.** TAKE A BRACE OF X-MAS PARTRIDGES (TWO BIRDS) THAT HAVE BEEN EITHER ROASTED OR BRAISED: CUT THEM INTO QUARTERS: DIP THEM INTO BEATEN AND SEASONED YOLKS OF EGGS: MAKE SOME BUTTER OR FRITURE (FRYING OIL) PERFECTLY HOT IN A FRYING PAN; PUT INTO IT- THE BIRDS, AND DO THEM OVER A MODERATELY HOT FIRE UNTIL THEY ARE BEAUTIFULLY BROWNED. HAVE A SIDE DISH OF CHILLED PAIRS, A TRUE LOVE CHRISTMAS SUPPER-----

Saloon Solutions: " DRY PUNCH", 2-Gallons of brandy, 1-pint of Jamaica Rum, ½ pint of Curacao, Juice of 6 lemons, ½ gallon of Tea, 1 ½ lb of white sugar. **Mix the brandy, rum Curacao, Lemon and tea thoroughly. Dissolve the sugar in just enough boiling water and add to the mixture. Add more sugar and lemon juice if desired. Bottle and keep on ice for three or four days, and the punch will be ready for use, but the longer it stands the better it gets. This punch is from and old New Orleans recipe.**
