
WALTER ROODE, REAL SON

Walter Roode of Portola, California, joined Carlin Camp 25 earlier this month. Walter is 98 years young, and is a Real Son. His father, Stephen W. Roode, served with Co. K, 9th Vermont Infantry. He was captured and paroled. He reenlisted and was with Co. B, 2nd Battalion, 17th U. S. Infantry. He was in the Battles of Chancellorsville, Gettysburg, Wilderness, and Petersburg, among others. National Commander-in-Chief Brad Schall, Department Commander Glen Roosevelt, Carlin Camp Commander John Riggs, Carlin Camp Senior Vice Commander/Historian and Department Historian David A. Davis, PCC, and Carlin Camp Graves Registration Officer Don Huffman met with Walter at Mimi's Café in Reno after a doctor's appointment on July 11. Walter's daughter-in-law Janie McBride brought Walter.

Following discharge from this unit he enlisted in the 17th Infantry Regiment of the Regular Army. On January 15, 1863 and discharged from this regiment of June 10, 1865. Walter is a member of the General Wm. Passmore Carlin Camp 25, SUVCW in Gardnerville-Reno, NV Camp Commander John Riggs appointed Walter an Officer of the Camp in 2011: Councilor. Montiel Helen (Roode) McAuley, Chicopee, MA: Father, Stephen Washington Roode, Enlisted as a Private on June 10, 1862. On July 9, 1862 he was in Co. K, 9th Regiment Vermont Infantry. Following discharge from this unit he enlisted in the 17th Infantry Regiment of the Regular Army on January 15, 1863 and discharged from this regiment on June 10, 1865.
