He also talked about meetings of the L.A. Civil War round Table, where our Brothers will be giving presentations on January 12, March 9, and June 15.

Treasurer, Br. Steve Magoffin, reported that the Camp has \$7,563.09 in the treasury, but that includes dues that must be shared with the Department, and National organization, in March.



Our Patriotic Instructor, Br. David Kidd, talked about focusing on the greatness of our Nation, even in tumultuous times, and Br. Gordon Seyffert read a very interesting letter from Gn. U.S. Grant. To his Father, in 1861, and Br. Kidd, spoke about flag symbolism, as part of the Good of the Order discussion.

An SUVCW Memorial service was conducted by Cdr. Smith, out of respect for our Brother Bill Nelson, who passed away on his 83rd birthday, November 1, 2020.


Rosecrans Report
