Southwest end of North Bridge Street, Winnemucca, NV.

Upright cinder block monument mounted on concrete slab. Monument measures 47.5 inches wide by 36 inches high by 7.75 inches thick, consisting of four courses of cinder block with a 14 in. x 24 in. bronze plaque. Pipes mounted in slab on either side of the monument to accommodate flags.

Dedicated 26 May 1968, supported by a community-based effort started in early 1967. Associated with ten metal fence posts and a hedge of mostly roses. Each post represented a part of Humboldt County, with Post 9 was designated for Civil War veterans.
