Nineteenth Century iron church bell, cast for a German Catholic congregation that relocated from Marysville to Williams. The bell was in storage in a basement at St. Joseph’s Catholic Church until being installed in the GAR Plot by the Knights of Columbus in 2002. The bell has no direct connection to Civil War soldiers or to the GAR, other than that it was installed in the GAR plot. The plot itself is associated with Corinth Post, No. 80, GAR.
